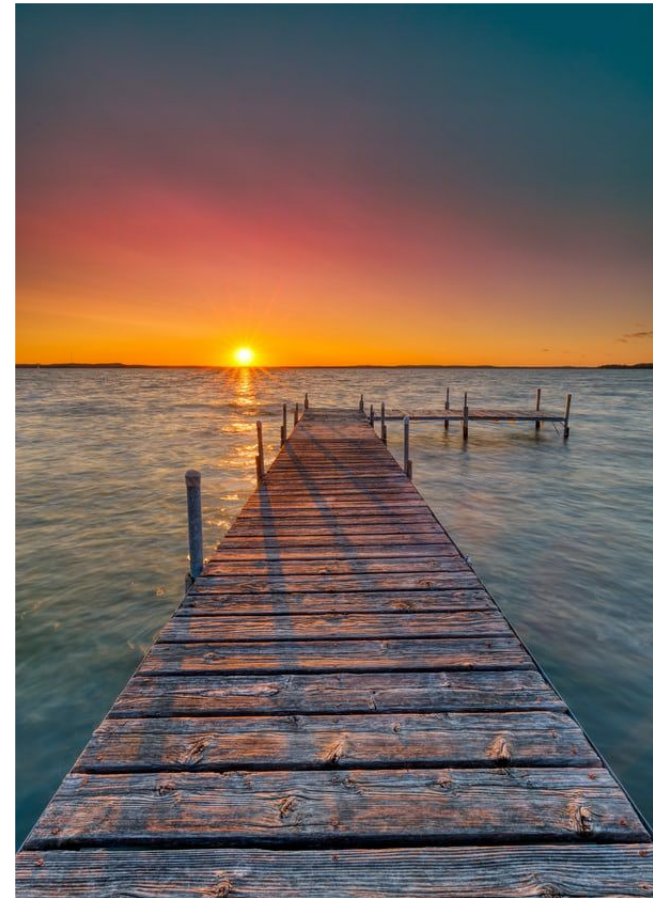


Obituary

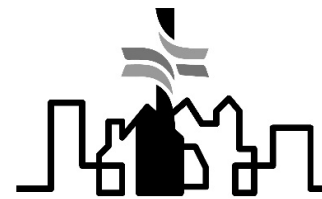
